

## **YOUNG AT HEART RETIREMENT LIVING EXHIBITIONS EXHIBITION TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### **1. Definitions**

- i) The Exhibition means Young at Heart Retirement Living Exhibition on the specified date.
- ii) "The Organiser" shall mean Young at Heart Retirement Living.
- iii) "The Exhibitor" means the company, firm, person, association or organisation to whom space has been allocated for the purpose of exhibiting at the Exhibition
- iv) "The Venue" means the space in which the Exhibition will be take place.

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### **2. Booking and allocation of display space**

- i) Upon the Exhibitor's request for display space to be booked with reference to the exhibition floor plan and the Organiser's approval, the Exhibitor will ensure payment of the full amount of the display space within 7 days of the approval being granted.

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### **3. Display Space and Display Arrangement**

- i) The Organiser shall provide table, chairs and electricity (if required) to the display space.

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### **4. Use of Display Space**

- i) The Exhibitor agrees not to assign or sublet any display space allocated without prior written consent from the Organiser nor to display or advertise goods or services other than those manufactured or carried by the Exhibitor in the normal course of business
- ii) Sales by auction are prohibited

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### **5. Height Limitations**

- i) The Exhibitor may not exceed the height limitations provided in the Exhibitor's Information which will be emailed to the Exhibitor prior to the event.

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### **6. Exhibitor Set-up**

- i) Exhibitors may set-up from 8am – 10am on the morning of the event.

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### **7. Opening Hours**

- i) The event is open to the public from 10am – 3pm.

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### **8. Removal of Exhibits**

- i) All exhibits shall be removed by 4pm on the day of the event.

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### **9. Cancellation by the Exhibitor**

- i) Once a display space allocation has been made in accordance with condition 2 above, any Exhibitor who subsequently decides for any reason to withdraw from the Exhibition shall immediately inform the Organiser. Upon cancellation, which shall be deemed to be the date the email sent, the Exhibitor shall be liable to pay the following cancellation charges:

Withdrawal 12 months before the event = 50% refund

Withdrawal 6 months before the event = 25% refund

Withdrawal less than 6 months before the event = no refund will be provided.

- ii) In the event of the Exhibitor withdrawing less than 6 months before the event, the Organiser, at his discretion and without obligation, may offer the Exhibitor an alternative stand at a future Exhibition.

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### **10. Change of location, curtailment or change of date of Exhibition**

- i) In the event that the venue shall, in the sole determination of the Organiser, become unfit or unavailable for occupancy by reason of fire, flood, tempest, terrorism acts of God or as a result of government intervention, malicious damage, strike, lockout, labour dispute, picketing, injunction or riot for which the Organiser has no control, or any issue of public health or safety, or should the Organiser decide that it is necessary or advisable to curtail, relocate the Exhibition or reduce the planned period for preparation, display or dismantling, the Organiser shall incur no liability for consequential loss, damage or expense howsoever caused or incurred.
- ii) Under any of these circumstances, the Organiser reserves the right to change the location of the Exhibition upon reasonable notice to the Exhibitor.
- iii) Under any of these circumstances, the Organiser reserves the right to alter the Exhibition Date.
